<i>Pool</i>	6 lane 25 metre; full electronic timing with 6 lane display scoreboard; anti-wave lane ropes; spectator area; cafeteria;
<i>Time</i>	Session 1; Warm up 8:30. Start at 9:30, ends at 12:30 Session 2; Warm up 1:30. Start at 2:30, ends at 5:30
<i>Ages</i>	As at 17 May 2008
<i>Age groups</i>	8 years, 9 years, 10 years and 11 years
<i>Events</i>	25ms all strokes (8 years) 25m Fly and 50m Back, Breast, Free (9 years) 50m Fly, Back, Breast, Free and 100 IM for (9-11 years) Relays; 4x25 freestyle 8-9 yrs and 10-11 yrs (mixed boys and girls) 4x25 medley relay 8-9 yrs and 10-11 yrs (mixed boys and girls) 8x25 canon freestyle relay; one boy and girl from each age group.
<i>Entry fees</i>	£3.50 per individual event; £7.50 per relay.
<i>Coaches pass</i>	£8.00 includes coaches programme, results sheet and a meal
<i>Awards</i>	Individual events; medals for the fastest three swimmers in each event and for relays. Flashes for 4 th -6 th in individual events. Best boy and girl awards in each age group and best club trophy.
<i>Officials</i>	Any swimming technical officials travelling with clubs are asked to make themselves available for assistance on the day.
<i>Closing date for entries</i>	Midnight, 18th April 2008.

Meet rules

- ❖ The meet shall be held under SASA rules.
- ❖ Ages as on the day of competition.
- ❖ All swimmers of Scottish clubs must have a current SASA registration number. (Swimmers from non-Scottish clubs must be registered with their governing body).
- ❖ The pool is 25 m long with 6 lanes, separated by anti wave ropes.
- ❖ Electronic timing will be in operation. If this fails, back up manual timing will be used.
- ❖ Swimmers, coaches and team managers must ensure that swimmers can safely dive into the deep end, as prescribed in current/planned legislation. There will be no diving into the shallow end of the pool.
- ❖ Those swimming in relay teams must also have entered an individual event
- ❖ Photographic and video equipment is not allowed in any area under the jurisdiction of the meet organiser without prior approval of the meet director.
- ❖ It is the responsibility of each club to ensure that its swimmers are aware of the meet rules and guidelines.

Entries

- ❖ All entries to be made by midnight, 18th April 2008. Entries to be made via Hy-Tek Team Manager, an events file for which can be obtained from Peter Lee at peterlee@swimscotland.org.uk. Please return entries by email.
- ❖ Withdrawals must be made to the recorders no later than 45 minutes prior to the start of each session, on the supplied withdrawal form.
- ❖ The promoters reserve the right to restrict entries. Entries will be accepted on a time basis. Clubs should ensure that times submitted are correct. Rejected entries will be refunded in full.

Events

- ❖ All events are Heat Declared Winners.
- ❖ Over the top starts may be used at the discretion of the promoter.
- ❖ Swimmers should report to the competition stewards in the designated marshalling area at least 4 heats in advance.
- ❖ For medley and freestyle relays, teams must comprise at least one boy and one girl and 2 from each age group.

Costs

Entry fees; £3.50 per individual event; £7.50 per relay
Coaches pass; £8.00, includes programme, results sheet and lunch
Other costs; Spectator entry £3.50, includes programme

Warm up and session times

Session 1; Warm up 8:30. Start at 9:30, ends at 12:30

Session 2; Warm up 1:30. Start at 2:30, ends at 5:30.

- ❖ The warm ups will commence when advised to do so by the marshals.
- ❖ Sprint lanes will be made available, 10 minutes before the end of each warm up session.
- ❖ Diving will be allowed in sprint lanes only, when instructed by the marshals.

Awards

- ❖ Individual events; medals for the fastest three swimmers in each event and for relays.
- ❖ Best boy and best girl prizes in each age group and best club trophy.
- ❖ Flashes for 4th- 6th in individual events.

Miscellaneous

- ❖ Accreditation has been applied for as a Level 2 event.
- ❖ The venue has a cafeteria and vending machines.
- ❖ There will be a raffle.
- ❖ The promoters reserve the right to exclude or refuse admission to any competitor team or official.
- ❖ Glassware is not permitted in the shower areas or poolside.
- ❖ Neither the host swimming club nor the Carnegie leisure centre can be held responsible for the loss or damage to swimmers, team staff's or spectators property. Swimmers are advised to secure property in the lockers provided and not to leave belongings lying around unattended.
- ❖ Outwith the pool area, swimmers should wear dry clothing and footwear at all times.
- ❖ Outdoor footwear must not be worn on the poolside.
- ❖ Anything not covered above or in the event programme, will be at the promoters discretion.
- ❖ The organisers reserve the right to vary the conditions as necessary.

Health and safety announcement
Controlling the use of photographic equipment

Due to a warning received on paedophile activity, the Scottish Amateur Swimming Association has decided that control of photographic equipment is required at all meets. In view of this, this meet will run under the following guidelines:

- *No photographic equipment (eg, camera, camcorder, mobile phones etc). is to be allowed on either poolside, spectator gallery or any other area under the jurisdiction of the meet organisers without prior approval of the meet director.*
- *Application to use photographic equipment must be made on the approved SASA form enclosed with this information.*
- *Application can be made on the day to the meet director or to the meet director's appointed official. Applicants must provide proof of identity when applying and carry such proof when intending to use their photographic equipment.*
