CARNEGIE SWIMMING CLUB WINTER OPEN MEET

Due to the on-going construction work at Tollcross and RCP, this will be a short course event this year. We have altered the programme of events slightly to better suit swimmers looking for entry times for the Scottish SC Nationals in December.

Date: Saturday 29th and Sunday 30th October 2011

Venue: FIPRE, Glenrothes.

Time: Warm up session 1 and 3 8:30 start 9:30
Warm up session 2 and 4 1:00 start 2:00

Pool: 6 lane 25 metre competition pool; swim down pool; full electronic timing with 6 lane display scoreboard; anti-wave lane ropes; spacious spectator area; free car parking; cafeteria.

Event sponsor: Sheppard Swim School

Ages: As at 30th October 2011

Age groups: 10/11 years, 12/13 years, 14/15 years, 16 and over yrs.

Entry fees: £5.50 individual event.

Coaches pass: £4.00 includes weekend programme and start sheets (per club)

Coaches meal: £9.00 per person per day or £5.00 per café voucher

Awards 50, 100 and 200m events: Medals will be presented to top 3 in each event.
50m sprint – additional cash prize for 1st, 2nd and 3rd (see later).
Best boy and girl in each age group
Best club based on overall points

Clubs are asked to provide technical officials and assist with timekeeping. In return we will provide free admission tickets for spectators, lunch for officials and travel expenses where appropriate.

Sheppard Swim school sprint event

We are grateful to Sheppard Swim school for again sponsoring our sprint event this year. The school runs training camps for all levels of swimmer over the summer, October and easter holidays. *Further event sponsor info available at <http://www.sheppardswimschool.co.uk>*

There will be cash prizes for those placed 1st to 3rd in the 50m freestyle sprint events, with separate events for males and females and for each age group (10-11, 12-13, 14-15 and 16 and over).

**Prize money – 10-11 and 12-13 yrs - £25 first place, £15 second, £10 third.
– 14-15 and 16 + yrs - £50 first place, £25 second, £10 third.**

Meet Rules

- The meet shall be held under S.A.S.A. laws.
- Ages as on the last day of the competition.
- All swimmers of Scottish clubs must have a current S.A.S.A. registration number. All swimmers of non-Scottish clubs must be registered with their governing body.
- Electronic timing will be in operation. In the event of electronic failure, back-up manual timing will be used.
- No photographic or video equipment will be allowed in any area under the jurisdiction of the meet organisers without prior approval of the meet director. Application must be made on the approved S.A.S.A. form.
- It is the responsibility of each club to ensure that their swimmers are aware of the meet rules and guidelines.

Entries

- Entries from composite teams and composite entries from groups of clubs will not be accepted.
- Closing date for entries Friday 30th September 2011
- All entries should be emailed to genland@supanet.com.
- Withdrawals must be made to the recorders no later than 45 minutes prior to the start of each session.
- The promoter's reserve the right to restrict entries if required. Entries will be accepted on time basis. Clubs should ensure entry times are accurate. Rejected entries will be refunded in full.
- There are no refunds for entries withdrawn after the draft programme is prepared.

Officials

- We ask club's assistance in providing timekeepers and qualified judges.
- Details of the judges and timekeepers available should be returned with the entry form. We will provide free spectator passes to clubs who pre - register their officials beforehand in this way. These passes will be available for collection from the gala convener at the start of each day.
- There will be **12 free spectator** passes available per session for the first 12 timekeepers to pre register – each pre registered timekeeper who signs in for duty will be given a spectator pass. (They can use this for viewing a later session or transfer it to someone else).
- There will also be **16 free spectator** passes available for the first 8 judges who pre register for each session. Each judge who has pre registered and reports for duty will earn two passes to use in any session. These are transferable.

Events

- Over the top starts may be used at the discretion of the promoter to facilitate the smooth running of the meet.
- Swimmers must report to the competition stewards in the designated marshalling area at least five heats in advance.
- Swimmers wishing to withdraw from finals must do so within 15 minutes from the end of their event. Failure to do so may result in that swimmer being withdrawn from the remainder of the meet.
- There will be a maximum of three reserves per event.

Miscellaneous

- The meet is licensed and a level 2 accreditation will be applied for.
- The promoters reserve the right to exclude or refuse admission to any competitor, spectator or team official.
- Swimmers and coaches must not take glassware into the showers or poolside and are liable for expulsion from the meet if they do.
- Neither Carnegie Swimming Club nor FIPRE can be held responsible for loss or damage to swimmer's, team staff or spectator's property. Swimmers are strongly advised to secure their property and not to leave belongings lying around unattended.
- Swimmers outwith the poolside must wear dry clothing and footwear at all times.
- Anything not covered above and not printed in the event programme will be at the promoter's discretion.
- Carnegie Swimming Club reserves the right to vary the above conditions as necessary.

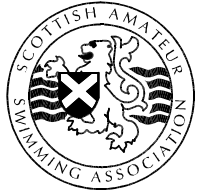
HEALTH AND SAFETY ANNOUNCEMENT

CONTROLLING THE USE OF PHOTOGRAPHIC EQUIPMENT

The Scottish Swimming Association has decided that control of photographic equipment is required at all meets. In view of this, the meet will run under the following guidelines:

- *No photographic equipment (e.g., camera, camcorder etc.) is to be allowed on either poolside, spectator gallery or any other area under the jurisdiction of the meet organisers without prior approval of the gala convenor.*
- *Application to use photographic equipment must be made on the approved S.A.S.A. form (enclosed with this information).*
- *Application can be made on the day to the gala convenor or to the gala convenor's appointed official. Applicants must provide proof of identity when applying and carry such proof when intending to use their photographic equipment.*
