Athletes can only compete for one club/team during the meet and must be eligible to swim for that club / team in accordance with R5.1.4.

To compete for a Scottish Club / Team at this event the athlete must have paid their current registration fee and be registered with SASA.

Athlete numbers for events will be agreed by the Swim Committee and the facility after entries are received. If it is necessary to reject entries, this will be done at the discretion of the Swim Committee.

Qualification times and consideration times are outlined in Appendix 2.

Entry Guide

This information regarding entry is a guide and is subject to change.

Entry into the competition will be made by clubs on official hytek entry files supplied if you experience ay issues with this option please contact sasaeastdistrictentries@gmail.com

It is likely that the competition as a whole will be oversubscribed and clubs should only enter athletes with coach approval.

Athletes not accepted to the event will have their entry fee will be refunded in full. Once the draft programme is issued **no refunds** will be given.

The East District Swim Committee reserve the right to make decisions on oversubscriptions in any way that is necessary to meet the conditions for the competition. Facility policies may restrict the numbers of athletes for the time available. This means that any athlete accepted into the meet, **may not** be able to swim all events they enter, to make best use of the time available.

Times must be submitted for all events entered. Times submitted must be achieved on or after 1st June 2024. Only Hy-Tek conversions for 50m times may be used. The following types of events will be accepted:

SASA accredited meets and time trials (L1 & L2)

Equivalent (L1 and L2) meets organised by ASA affiliated counties or clubs or other World Aquatics affiliated organisations.

Proof of time <u>MUST BE SUBMITTED</u> for the meet; random checks will be undertaken, and clubs may be asked pre and post event to provide additional information. If no proof of time is submitted, then all entries will be rejected.

Relays Entry

- No limit to number of teams entered.
- Licenced times should be submitted for each team member and reserves.
- The submitted relay entry time should be the sum of the licenced times for each provisional team member.

Relay Team Lines and Changes



	 Team lines for morning relays should be submitted no later than one hour prior to the start of the session the relay is to be swum in – relay teams may be withdrawn from the event if team lines are not posted on time. Relay lines should include any potential reserves. Team staff should confirm Junior teams on the relay lines. Changes can be made up to 1 hour prior to the start of the appropriate session
	using the relay team line form at the recorder desk.
Withdrawals	 Withdrawals including reserves prior to the first day of the Meet should be notified via the electronic withdrawal supplied. Withdrawals, including reserves, for session 1 must be notified no later than 1800 on Friday 14th November via the electronic withdrawal form. Withdrawals, including reserves, for Session 4 must be notified to the recorders desk no later than 1800 on Saturday 15th November. Withdrawals, including reserves, for the afternoon sessions, must be notified to the recorders desk no later than 1000 on the day of the event. Finals Withdrawals, including reserves, from finals must be notified to the recorders desk within 30 minutes of the finalist's lists being published or announced. Any finalists withdrawing from a final in a way as to prevent a reserve taking part shall be suspended from all further events at the Open meet unless in the case of a genuine illness or emergency. NOTE: withdrawals from heats or finals on medical grounds during the event should be

Accreditation	There will be no athlete accreditation passes provided.					
Passes	All Coaches and Team Managers must hold the relevant qualification/certification for their role and have a valid annual (2025) Scottish Swimming District or National Pass for the club they are representing at the meet.					
	Access to the event will be refused where no pass is provided. All annual Scottish Swimming District and National passes are available to order via <u>JustGo</u> .					
	Team Staff from non-Scottish clubs should contact sasaeastdistrictswimming@gmail.com for accreditation by 7 th November 2025 .					
	Accreditation will not be issued to any Team Staff unless a person has a valid Disclosure Certificate/PVG/CRB through Scottish Swimming/Swim England/Swim Wales.					
	All Coaches and Team staff MUST enter via the front door and have their passes verified before proceeding to poolside. No entry to poolside will be allowed without a valid pass. Passes must be worn and clearly visible at all times. Anyone not displaying and wearing their Pass will be asked to leave the poolside or athlete area immediately.					
	The numbers of qualified coach and poolside personnel allowed on poolside with each club will be restricted to a maximum of two persons for up to the first 10 athletes per session, thereafter a ratio of 1:10 should be applied. Names of all Team staff attending the event must be provided to sasaeastdistrictswimming@gmail.com at least 3 days prior to the event.					
	A WhatsApp broadcast will be used for Meet information and start sheets in the run up to and during the event. The broadcast code will be issued to entry secretaries and will be					



available to confirmed coaches and entry secretaries only. Coaches and team staff should ensure the District mobile number is added as a contact to receive these.				
Please note coaches and entry secretaries MUST subscribe to the broadcast associated with the weekend by the following date - late subscriptions will not be accepted. 1800 Wednesday 12 th November 2025.				
Spectating will be available at the venues on a first come first served basis. This is subject to facility guidelines in place at the time of the event.				
Medals will be awarded as follows:				
East District Open Champion 1st, 2nd, and 3rd 1st (where the winner is not also the Open Champion) Junior Champion 1st (aged under 17 as at 31st December 2025)				
The East District Champion and Junior Champion must be registered and be swimming under an East District Club as their first club.				
A Junior relay must consist of 4 athletes, all of whom must be aged under 17 years on the 31 st December 2025 and should be identified as Junior on the relay team lines by Team staff.				
There will be no formal medal presentations, medals can be collected from the medal desk for both HDW and Finals on completion of the individual events.				
The meet organisers are well aware of the wide range of devices including mobile telephones which have photographic and filming capabilities. This enables the capture of both static and moving images. It should be acknowledged that the majority of images taken within Scottish Swimming licensed meets are appropriate and taken in good faith.
