Entry Process

Entries will be by Computer File Only, files can be obtained by emailing midlandsmeeentries@gmail.com

Consideration times

Competitors must enter times achieved in accredited competitions held from 1st January 2024 and either be 25 metre pool times or conversions to 25 metre pool times (Official conversion tables: Hy-tek standard conversion or Swim England conversion tables may be used).

A proof of entry times report is required in line with SW2.1.2.5. Random checks on entry times will be carried out prior to and during the event. Any athletes submitting an unaccredited entry time will automatically be withdrawn from all entered events and will forfeit all entry fees.

The organisers reserve the right to restrict entries to ensure a good standard of competition. If it is necessary to reject entries, this will be done based on entry time, slowest to fastest.

There are no consideration times for relay events, please submit individual times for each relay team member and all reserves. No Time entries shall not be accepted.

There is limited seating available for spectators in the balcony. There is no set entry fee however we will be accepting donations. Spectators wishing to take photographs or videos at the event must complete the application form via the QR Code displayed at the venue and agree to the photography policy.

All competition in Scotland will be operated in line with Scottish Government and Public Health Scotland and Scottish Swimming Guidance, current at the time of the competition taking place. Full details will be issued nearer the date of the competition.

All competitors and other attendees are required to adhere to the conditions of the competition to ensure that we stay compliant and safe. Anyone failing to follow the conditions will be refused access or removed from the venue and no refund will be offered.

Mobile phones and devices that can take images are not permitted to be used in the changing rooms.

Competition Disclaimer

In the event of cancellation or abandonment of the event, refunds, if any, will be made at the absolute discretion of SASA Midland District. SASA Midland District will have no legal liability to make a refund or to pay any form of consequential or indirect damage such as loss of enjoyment, travel, catering and accommodation.

Eligibility

All competitors must be a registered member of a club affiliated to SASA Midland District and a registered member of the Scottish Amateur Swimming Association having paid their current registration fee.

A Swimmer can only compete for one Club/Team during the meet and must be eligible to swim for their Club/Team in accordance with Company Rule 5.1

Only swimmers that are affiliated with a Midland District club, as their first claim club, are eligible to win Midland District trophies, as per M.R.3 of our constitution,

At the discretion of the SASA Midland District Swimming Committee and under exceptional circumstances, on application a swimmer who does not meet the eligibility criteria may be allowed to compete in the meet.

Para Swimmers

Para Swimmers who do not meet the consideration times will be permitted to enter the meet providing they have a current para swimming classification. This must be marked on the entry file. There are no para specific events and there shall not be a para final for any event.

- A proof of time report is required on entry and there will be random checks on times. Clubs may be asked for additional information about the times entered.

In the event that a session or an event within this meet is oversubscribed, entries will be accepted fastest to slowest per age group. Some of the events may have limited heats.

WITHDRAWALS/POOLSIDE PASSES/GENERAL INFORMATION

Withdrawals

Refunds will only be issued on Medical Grounds if a Medical Certificate is presented. Refunds will not be issued after the Meet Programme has been finalised in any other circumstances.

Please note: Any late withdrawals from Heats on medical grounds should be discussed with the Meet Director prior to being submitted to the Recorders.

Heats

Any withdrawals (including reserves) prior to the first day of the Meet should be notified using the online form below.

Online Withdrawal Form

Deadline – 2pm Friday 7th November 2025

Withdrawals will be accepted on the day at the recorders desk before the start of the warm-up for the session the athlete is being withdrawn from.

Athletes failing to comply with the above (except in the case of a genuine illness or proven emergency) will be liable to a £10 fine for each late or undeclared withdrawal

Finals

Competitors wishing to withdraw from a Final (including reserves) must inform the Recorders in writing on the form provided within 30 minutes of Finalists Lists having been published or announced. Any competitor withdrawing from a final in such a manner as to prevent a reserve taking part (except in the case of a genuine illness or proven emergency) shall be suspended from all further events at the meet. Athletes failing to comply with the above (except in the case of a genuine illness or proven emergency) will be liable to a £20 fine for each late or undeclared withdrawal.

Please note: Any late withdrawals from Heats or Finals on medical grounds during the event should be discussed with the Meet Director prior to being submitted to the Recorders.

Data protection

In order to operate this meet, we have a legitimate interest to collect and process some basic personal data from all competitors, specifically name, gender, date of birth.

This data will be held securely and only used for the purposes of managing the meet and reporting results. Dates of Birth (DOB) will only be shared with:

- Scottish Swimming for the purpose of maintaining the National Database which is used for Squad Selection and
- Swim England for inclusion on Rankings

Names, eligibility category and age (not DOB) will be retained and will be shared with attending clubs and may be published for the purpose of reporting and keeping records.

Event Regulations

Entry and Entries to all events is expressly subject to the Event Regulations on our website which can be found [here](#) and may, where appropriate, also require compliance with the facility provider's regulations.

SASA Midland District reserves absolutely the right to eject from events any person failing to comply with each and all of the Event Regulations.

Transgender and Non Binary Competition Policy

As of the 1st January 2024 the Scottish Swimming Transgender & Non-Binary Competition Policy will be implemented nationally across all aquatics sports. The policy and FAQs can be found [HERE](#). Any policy related matters that arise during the event should be reported to and will be recorded by the Meet Convenor/Lead Referee and these matters will be communicated to and managed post event by the relevant Scottish Swimming Staff. At no point will members be challenged on the day of a competition with any matters being resolved post event.

As a result of this policy being implemented, any competitor intending to compete within the Female category at this event will be required to provide confirmation that their birth sex is female when signing up to the meet conditions through entry. By entering the Female category, athletes are therefore confirming their birth sex is female and are eligible to compete in the Female category.

Marshalling

Swimmers must report to marshalling for heats at least 5 races prior to their race. If a swimmer has not reported to marshalling by the time their race is in the final call room, they will not be permitted to swim and a reserve, if available, shall swim in their place.

The final call room shall be the last row of seats in marshalling prior to moving to the blocks

Swimwear

Aquatics GB and Scottish Swimming advise that World Aquatics BL 8.1 only applies to Olympic Games and WORLD AQUATICS events. A suit check will only be made if a World or European record is being claimed. There is not a requirement for officials to check that costumes are on the approved World Aquatics list. Bylaws BL 8.2 and BL 8.3 cover our requirements for design and material.

SW8.0 Scottish Swimming Rules

SW8.8 Swimwear Policy

SW 8.8.1 For events held under the direct jurisdiction and control of Scottish Swimming the Scottish Swimming "Swimwear Policy" shall also apply. This policy is included in full in Appendix 1 of these regulations.

Swimmers 13 years and younger cannot now compete wearing technical suits in Scottish Swimming licensed or registered events. For further information and FAQ's please see [Swimwear | Scottish Swimming](#)

Team Staff

Scottish Swimming have introduced a new pass system, which will allow coaches to apply for an annual District pass, which is verified and checked by Scottish swimming for compliance, prior to issue. This District pass can be applied for at no charge.

All poolside Staff must have one of the above in place. Without a valid pass the member of staff will NOT be permitted entry to the event.

All passes must be printed and worn by all team personnel and always made visible.

Teams will be limited to 2 members of staff for the first 20 swimmers and 1 member of staff for each 10 swimmers thereafter.

Applying for a Pass

Applicants:- The following criteria needs to be met to allow you to apply for a pass:-

must hold a valid Child Wellbeing and Protection in Sport (CWPS) certificate or CWPS Renewal Award	must hold a valid Safeguarding certificate with your Governing Body
have a photograph on your Just Go Membership profile (Photographs should be taken under the same rules as passport photographs)	

District Annual Poolside Passes cannot be used at National Events, a separate pass should be purchased from Scottish Swimming.

MSW6.2 Midland District Clubs and teams entering swimmers in any District Meet/Championships , with the exception of clubs entering teams that are wholly 1st claim athletes to a University club, must provide the names of technical officials attending each session of the Meet, to comply with the requirements of MSW6.3. This information must be received by the District STO Convenor no later than 7 days before the first day of the Meet on the appropriate form.

AOE Operator & Recorder count as a Judge 2 level

Appointed Announcers & Marshalls count as Judge 1 level

Any changes or additions to the submitted officials form on the day must be clearly indicated to the Meet Referee or District STO Convenor if present.

MSW6.4 For the purposes of determining how many swimmers a Club has entered into a Midland District Meet or championships, only swimmers entered into individual events shall be counted.

MSW6.5 A Midland District club failing to provide Technical Officials in accordance with the criteria in SW6.3, will be subject to a fine as agreed at the AGM for each session in which the required officials are not present. The Midland District Swimming & Championship Convenor in conjunction with the Midland District STO Convenor may agree to wave fines for a meet providing sufficient technical officials are present for the duration of the meet.

MSW6.6 Where the Meet or Session Referees agree that there are sufficient Swimming Technical Officials present to ensure adequate cover in any session, an official may be mentored at the next level for which they were training. All officials will count at their existing qualification level as per MSW6.3.

STO Poolside Uniform

In accordance with the Aquatics GB and Scottish Swimming Rules, the poolside uniform for technical officials at Midland District Events is:

White top,
Black trousers, dress or skirt and must be below the knees
Black poolside shoes, Black socks and Black accessories

Catering & Refreshments

All technical officials should bring their own water bottle. Water fountains will be available at the pool.

Officials who volunteer for both sessions on any given day will be provided with Lunch and refreshments.

AWARDS & PRESENTATIONS

Medals

Medals will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd in each Age Group for individual and relay events.

Trophies

The St Thomas Trophies shall be awarded for the fastest overall Male & Open and Female Swimmers in the 100m IM

Presentations

Presentations of medals shall be in accordance with the event schedule on page 6. Team staff must ensure that athletes report to the marshalling area for medal presentations and are wearing Team Kit in order to receive their medals.
