<b>Meet Objective</b>	To mark the 140 <sup>th</sup> anniversary of Burntisland Amateur Swimming Club & Humane Society we are pleased to invite Clubs to join us at this Meet which will be run as a Level 2 to enable swimmers to achieve accredited times while helping us to celebrate this special milestone.

<b>Venue</b>	Michael Woods Sports & Leisure Centre – Viewfield, Glenrothes, KY6 2RD
<b>Session Times</b>	Warm-up Session 1: 08:30 – Start 09:30 Warm-up Session 2: 13:00 – Start 14:00 Start times may be adjusted once entries have been received.
<b>Pool</b>	8 lane, 25m competition pool: full electronic timing and scoreboard; anti-wave lane ropes; spectator areas; car parking; cafeteria.
<b>Promoter</b>	Burntisland Amateur Swimming Club & Humane Society
<b>Events</b>	50m & 100m Backstroke, Breaststroke, Freestyle & Butterfly 100m & 200m Individual Medley, 200m (4 x 50m) Freestyle Relay – Mixed teams will be considered for each age group – if a Club does not have sufficient Swimmers to enter a Relay Team for a particular age group, then Swimmers can be aged-up to complete a Team.
<b>Age Groups</b>	8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16 & 17+. Age on the 26 <sup>th</sup> of September 2026.

<b>Entry Deadline</b>	Wednesday 9 <sup>th</sup> of September 2026 by 21:00.
<b>Entry Fees</b>	£6 per individual swim £10 per Relay Team No Entries will be accepted without the correct fee.
<b>Awards</b>	Medals awarded to the top 3 places in each event and Age Group (Male & Open/Female). The winners are heat declared winners. The heat declared winner Relay Team for each Age Group will be awarded medals. There will be no presentations, medals will be available from the medal desk.
<b>Officials</b>	Each Club is asked to provide 1 or more Officials qualified at Judge 1 Level or above, and 2 Timekeepers for every 10 swimmers entered to the event. Your support will be greatly appreciated to make this L2 meet possible. Lunch and refreshments will be provided for STOs helping all day. Please complete the <a href="#">FORM</a> for STOs. There will be opportunity to support Officials requiring mentoring towards completing their accreditation.
<b>Meet Rules</b>	The meet will be held under S.A.S.A rules and regulations. Scottish Swimming “Swimwear Policies” shall apply. Bylaws BL 8.2 and BL 8.3 cover the requirement for design and material. Volunteers at poolside will be required to display the appropriate Scottish Swimming Event pass at all times in accordance with current Scottish Swimming Guidelines. It is the responsibility of each club to ensure that their swimmers are aware of the meet rules and guidelines. Over the top starts may be used at the discretion of the promoter to facilitate the smooth running of the meet. Swimmers must report to the competition stewards in the designated marshalling area at least five heats in advance.
<b>Eligibility</b>	All swimmers of Scottish clubs must have a current S.A.S.A registration number. All swimmers of non-Scottish clubs must be registered with their governing body.

	<p>The Scottish Swimming Transgender &amp; Non-Binary Competition Policy was implemented on the 1<sup>st</sup> of January 2024. The policy and FAQs can be found <a href="#">HERE</a>. Any policy related matters that arise during the event should be reported to and will be recorded by the Meet Convenor/Lead Referee and these matters will be communicated to and managed post event by the relevant Scottish Swimming Staff. At no point will members be challenged on the day of a competition with any matters being resolved post event. By entering the Female category, athletes are therefore confirming their birth sex is female and are eligible to compete in the Female category.</p>
<p><b>Keeping Everyone Safe</b></p>	<p>We want to ensure the competition, as far as possible for everyone attending, is a safe and healthy environment that will be enjoyable and successful.</p> <p>All competitors and other attendees are required to adhere to the conditions of the competition to ensure that we stay compliant and safe. Anyone failing to follow the conditions will be refused access or removed from the venue and no refund will be offered.</p> <p>Swimmers must wear dry clothing and footwear at all times when not on poolside or in the changing rooms.</p> <p>Swimmers and coaches must not take glassware into the showers or poolside and are liable for expulsion from the meet if they do.</p> <p>In line with Scottish Swimming guidance, all volunteers that are at poolside will require a valid Volunteer Poolside pass for this event, please ensure all volunteers, including Technical Officials have a pass in advance of the event and display this at all times when entering the event.</p> <p>The meet organisers are well aware of the wide range of devices including mobile telephones which have photographic and filming capabilities. This enables the capture of both static and moving images.</p> <p>It should be acknowledged that the majority of the images taken within Scottish Swimming licensed meets are appropriate and taken in good faith. However, images of children and adults can be misused, and sharing images widely without consent may betray the confidence or identity of a child or adult, which could present a risk of harm to that individual if common sense procedures are not followed.</p>

	<p>Parents and carers of participants under the age of 18 who wish to take images are requested to focus on their own children as much as reasonably possible and to avoid including other children and images, particularly if those images are being shared with family and friends or through social media platforms.</p> <p>Whilst it is acknowledged that parents/carers wish to celebrate the achievements of their own children when taking part in aquatic events, it should be recognised and respected that other parents/carers may not wish for their child's image to be taken and shared in this way.</p> <p>The meet organisers are committed to ensuring that all children who participate in this meet are able to take part in an enjoyable, safe environment and be safeguarded from harm. If you have any child safeguarding concerns at the event, please contact the Event Convenor immediately to disclose your concerns.</p> <p>Please refer to the <a href="#">Scottish Swimming Photography Statement</a> for more information.</p>
<p><b>Entry Guidance</b></p>	<p>Entries will be accepted on a time basis with recorded times preferred, but accurate Coaches' times will also be accepted. Since this is a L2 meet, Coaches must ensure Swimmers are of a suitable standard as disqualifications for infractions will be enforced.</p> <p>The organiser reserves the right to restrict entries or make decisions on oversubscriptions in order to meet the conditions for the meet.</p> <p>To ensure Burntisland ASC swimmers will each get at least one swim in the gala, up to the first 6 spaces in each 8+ event will be reserved to Burntisland ASC swimmers as selected by the organisers. Thereafter, priority will be fastest to slowest per age group with any oversubscriptions being refunded.</p> <p>Oversubscribed entries will be refunded in full. Refunds will be processed after the event's conclusion.</p> <p>The organiser reserves the right to accept relay entries on the day and to agree any mix of age and eligibility in order to have swimmers participate.</p>
<p><b>Draft Programme,</b></p>	<p>A draft programme will be issued via email by <b>Monday 14<sup>th</sup> of September 2026.</b></p>

<p><b>Start Sheets and Withdrawals</b></p>	<p>Refunds will not be given for withdrawals after the draft programme has been issued.</p> <p>Withdrawals must be received by <b>Thursday 24<sup>th</sup> of September 2026 at noon.</b></p> <p>Start sheets will be issued via email on <b>Friday 25<sup>th</sup> of September 2026</b> or sooner if possible. Start sheets may not be available at the event. Coaches, Team Managers, Poolside Helpers and Spectators must bring their own copies.</p>
<p><b>Spectators</b></p>	<p>Spectators will be allowed entry to the spectator gallery for a fee of £3 per session or £5 for a full day.</p> <p>It may be necessary to limit the number of spectators to accommodate swimmers in the gallery.</p>
